



# Catcher Vessel Checklist for 2018/19 Crab Rationalization Fisheries

#### **Pre-Season**

□ ADF&G Fisheries Preseason Registration (by Sep 24) (Bristol Bay red king, eastern and western Bering Sea Tanner & Bering Sea snow crab only)

## **Before Fishing**

National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS)

- □ NMFS Federal Crab Vessel Permit
- □ NMFS Federal fisheries permit (if retaining groundfish for bait)
- □ NMFS IFQ permit
- □ NMFS IFQ hired master permit
- □ NMFS Daily Fishing Logbook
- □ Transmitting VMS (NMFS)

Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission (CFEC)

- □ CFEC triangle sticker (intact and legible) and plate (vessel registered)
- □ Valid ADF&G commercial fishing vessel number
- □ CFEC Interim Use Permit (Gear Card) (Separate card(s) required if fishing CDQ)

## Alaska Department of Fish and Game (ADF&G)

- □ Determine if observer coverage is required. Please notify ADF&G observer program 10 days prior to fishing (Dutch Harbor).
- □ Pre-fishery inspection (aka tank check)
- □ ADF&G Vessel Registration (Dutch Harbor, Akutan, King Cove)
- □ File gear co-operative use form with ADF&G if other vessels will be sharing, operating, or transporting your gear

United States Coast Guard (USGS)

- □ USCG Commercial Fishing Vessel Safety Decal
- □ USCG notification 24 hours prior to leaving port with pots

#### **After Fishing**

- □ Check out with ADF&G within 72 hours of completion of fishing operations or gear storage vessels can call as soon as they pull the last pot in a registration area.
- □ Gear must be in storage within 14 days after completion of fishing operations
- □ Registration becomes invalid after 14 days of inactivity
- □ Send in yellow logbook copies at end of quarter to NMFS. ADF&G requests the goldenrod observer copy of the logbook pages.
